## Go.

It is a small, two-letter word. Yet in this one word is the very heart of Christ. He is a God who is not distant – He came to us. The Bible says, *“The Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us”* (John 1:14).

The Lord Jesus Christ did not wait for man to come to Him. That was not going to happen. Instead, He came to us. The Father said, **“Go,”** and He went.

It is with this same passion that He said to His followers, *“As my Father hath sent me, even so send I you”* (John 20:21). Can you hear the voice of a loving God still asking, *“Whom shall I send, and who will **go** for us?”*

When Isaiah heard this question he responded, *“Here am I; send me.”* Immediately the Lord said, **“Go, and tell this people...”** (Isaiah 6:9). God is looking for servants who will **go** with His message. The little word **go** is used 1,544 times in the Word of God. Each time you see the word **go** allow it to serve as a reminder of God’s plan and your purpose.

The little word **go** is found at the beginning of some of the greatest words ever used by man: God, good, godly, goodwill, goal, gospel. It is a word of deliberate action, of divine advance, and of definite aim. We **go** for the Lord, *with* the gospel, and *to* a lost world.

To **go** requires steps to be taken. These Bible lessons have been designed to help you take specific, immediate steps to **go** with the gospel. Begin where you are. Tell the Lord you desire to **go** with Him to those who need Christ. Take one step.

**Go** is not optional; it is imperative. **Go** is not an invitation; it is a command. May God help us all to hear His voice and obey His command! May God help us to **go**.

*“Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should **go** and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain...”* (John 15:16).



**Text: Revelation 22:6-21**

**Lesson Overview:**

We begin our study at the end of the Bible. If a man's last words are important, how much more are God's final inspired words in the Bible? His last command should be our first priority. The central truth of this lesson: we must all be ready for the second coming of Christ.

**Lesson Aims:**

- To understand the imminent return of Jesus Christ.
- To identify the opportunities that will end when Christ comes.
- To emphasize the urgency with which the gospel must be given.

**Introduction:**

If you knew that in 12 hours you would stand before God, what would you do with those hours? If you knew that in 12 hours someone that you know – a family member, a friend, a neighbor, a co-worker or fellow student – would leave this world, what would you want to say to them? *What if you only had 12 hours?*

Few people know the specific hour of their death. No one knows the hour of Christ's return (Acts 1:7). Every day should be lived as the last. The things that would matter most on your last day on earth should matter most today. We are all living on the edge of eternity.

**Key Verses:**

*"And he said unto me, These sayings are faithful and true: and the Lord God of the holy prophets sent his angel to shew unto his servant the things which must shortly be done. Behold I come quickly: blessed is he that keepeth the sayings of the prophecy of this book" (Revelation 22:6-7).*

Notice the three times in Revelation chapter 22 that Christ repeats His promise:

- *"Behold, I come quickly" (Revelation 22:7).*
- *"And, behold, I come quickly" (Revelation 22:12).*
- *"Surely I come quickly" (Revelation 22:20).*
