**Choir:** (*Singing*) "The Lamb of Bethlehem. . ."

**Joseph:** "Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world."  
[John 1:29]

**Choir:** (*Singing*) "The Lamb of Calvary. . ."

**Joseph:** "He was oppressed, and He was afflicted, yet He opened not His mouth:  
He is brought as a lamb to the slaughter. . ." [Isaiah 53:7a]

**Choir:** (*Singing*) "The Spotless Sacrifice Who made salvation free."

**Joseph:** "And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of  
their testimony." [Revelation 12:11a]

**Choir:** (*Singing*) "The Lamb of God left heav'n above. What matchess grace, what  
wondrous love! The Lamb of Bethlehem is Christ Who died for me."

**Joseph:** "Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible  
things, as silver and gold. . . But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a  
lamb without blemish and without spot." [1 Peter 1:18,19]
